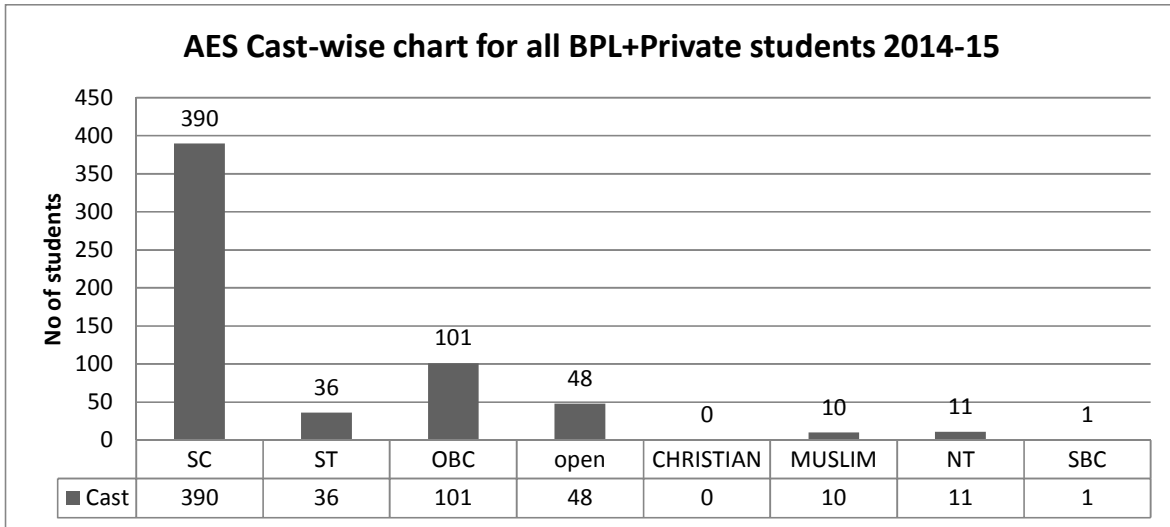
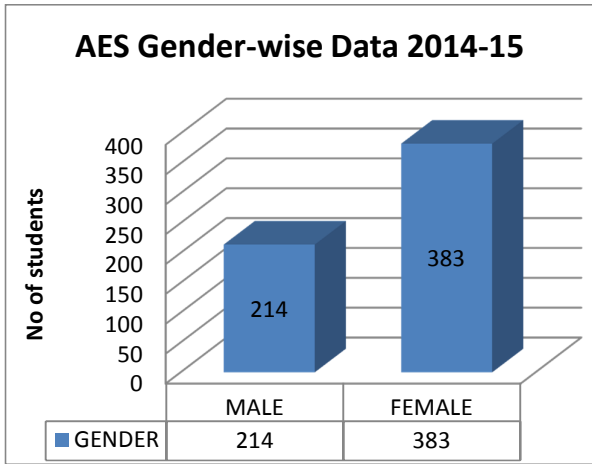
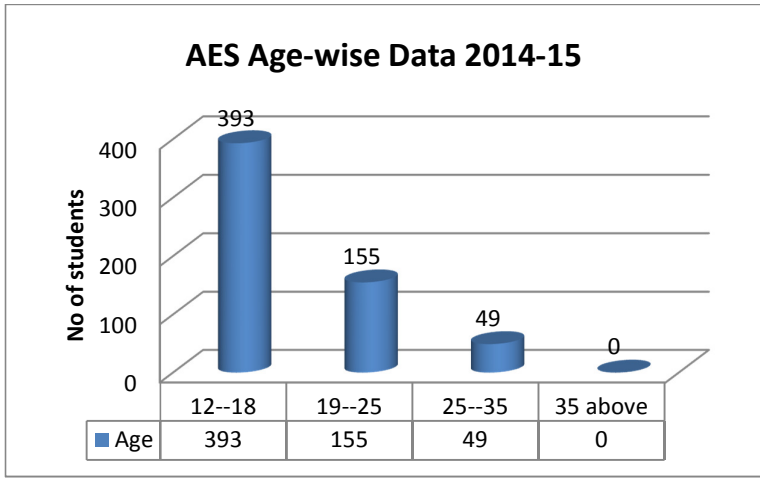

In **1 year** time **597** young **men=214** and **women=383** in the age-group of (**12 to 18 yrs=393, 19 to 25 yrs=155, 25 to 35yrs=49**) from different caste background (**SC=390+ ST=36 + OBC=101 + open=48 + Muslim=10 + NT=11+ SBC=1**) mix together without discrimination will be confident and competent in their IT skills with **25%** will gain employment and others will enter into higher education at Diploma or Degree level thus they feel confident, equal, free, independent in caste dominated India.

The project has a **14 yrs.** long and successful track record in Nagpur of delivering education and has a strong approach to sustainability. During the period project has attracted **247 students including boys=85 and girls=162** those were able to pay a fee for education and trained these students alongside those needing support.

Status of course completion (Private students **247**) : Passed = 153 Dropouts = 52 Regular (exam pending) = 42
 Status of course completion (BPL students **350**) : Passed = 183 Dropouts = 60 Regular (exam pending) = 107
 Dropout rate = 20% Passed=56% (it will increase up to 75% when rest 149 students will give exam)

Students working together in this way breaks down many caste barriers in a supported environment. Friendship, courage, independence, decision-making, determination, confidence, vision and professionalism are some of the many benefits students gained through the current Aryaloka project.

Women's need

In India the education and job prospects of girls and women is very low. Many girls do not complete their education, their families do not promote education for them and they are married off at a young age. They are not seen as potential contributors to the family financial situation. The Aryaloka Education Society has for the last **1 year (April-14 to March-15)** attracted up to **65%** women students. This has had a significant effect on these women helping them get computer and office related jobs, from simple data entry to administrators. This has shown their family and community that in this current age women can earn and contribute. It is changing the way women and societies see women. These women who attend Aryaloka are role models for their siblings and local community.

MAJOR ACHEIEVEMENTS

- During this period we were able to buy a land and building for Computer training centre will help to increase the number of beneficiaries and will start some new projects counselling and career guidance centre.
- During the period we purchased 3 generators for electricity for 3 branches now students can learn computer skills even electricity gets off. It's helpful to increase our reputation. Beneficiaries are very happy.
- It's a very satisfied experience that we opened up our new branch in Raipur, Chhattisgarh state.
- It's a very satisfied experience to see how the young students are mix together without caste discrimination.
- It's a satisfied experience to see how the co coordinators are functioning independently.
- We have successfully delivered computer education to **350** students from disadvantage background.
- As per the record out of **336** students those completed and passed the exams **122** students got jobs in computer related fields like Data entry operator, accounting, reception, publication, back office work, Computer designing, etc.

- We were able to attract **247** fee paying students that increase our confidence to move towards sustainability.
- We have open up the doors in IT field for **597** students in **1 year time**.
- **122** students who receive job are in position to support their families. Most can earn enough to support their educational expenses.
- **199** students are carrying on further Academic Education. We have surveyed nearly **336** students and received the data.
- Some are earning and learning together. Collect all the information through phonecalls and personal communication.
- Students receive equality based treatment and environment regardless of their background (SC/ST/VJNT/Hindus/Muslim/ Tribal)
- Students develop communication skills, understanding, respectfulness, discipline and mature which help them to become effective in workplace
- Internship programs are a successful strategy which provided opportunity to over **4 students** to get work experience. They gain experience in teaching IT skills, earning and personality development increasing employment prospect.

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CHANGES TO PLANNED ACTIVITIES

We haven't done any major changes to activities.....

CHALLENGES

- It's a challenging to raised rest of the funds about 28 lacs rupees (approx. 30000 GBP) to pay a next instalment of land and building by the end of FEB 2016.
- It is challenging to bring/collect students from most disadvantage background.
- It's even challenging to keep their interest for learning computer skills.
- Most of students found they are not regular on course its challenging to keep them regular.
- It's challenging to teach the computer courses easily to BPL students than fee paying students.
- It's challenging to do further follow up with the students those were completed course.
- Negative publicity created by competitor institute in the same neighborhood will result in reduced paid and BPL student and publicity going down
- ACE not insured assets and premises.
- We haven't bought health insurance

LESSONS LEARNED AND ADJUSTMENTS TO PROJECT

- We have decided to start donation campaign in UK, Australia and Newzeland as soon as possible so that we will able to raise 30000 GBP by the end of FEB 2016.
- We will request Karuna Trust to give some contribution as well.
- We have also decided to start fund raising in India for furnishing 1st floor.
- We have decided to buy a health insurance as soon as possible in further six months.
- We have decided to insured the office furniture and computers for theft and burn.

- We have trained field worker to make a contact with the beneficiaries those have completed the course successfully in terms of getting more output whether they got jobs or not.
- Record should be proper.
- Learning in regards with consequences of creating Objectives, budget, plan, maintain computerized data, learn project background
- The staff must do work day to day not keep it as pending the work.
- ACE must follow the students who are not regular.
- Filling feedback forms from BPL plus Private students helps to improve our programme and project.
- Each co-coordinator realize their potential how to contribute to the success and aims of the ACE.
- ACE has established a good reputation and recognition with MKCL as organization with increasingly highest number of students, BPL support, English programme etc.

My name is Sunita Kamble and I am married and have a daughter age 2 yrs. But now I am living with my mom, my father died in my childhood. I got married at the age of 22 and my husband used to work in private sector. The life was average for first 2 and half yrs and suddenly my husband started drinking alcohol. He stopped doing job and soon we came in deep financial crises. He is also not allowing me to go for job. We also used to quarrel lot and I deeply came in to frustration and left husbands home and started living with my mom. My mother washing up dishes at some houses and looks after herself in minimum income. To pay the rent and look after my baby it's a very big deal for me. Later on my husband has gone out without informing us. I tried to lodge a complaint in Police

Station but didn't know yet where he is? At last I have decided to find job but because of no IT skills I didn't get any suitable job. I was totally collapse and in hopeless, very frustrated and painful situation. Later on Darshan Sir helps me and encourage me to join MSCIT, DTP course at Aryaloka Computer Education. I wasn't even able to pay a exam fees of the course. So Darshan allowed me to join the course free. The IT course created a new hope in my life. I can say that because of IT course I got new life. During the course I got a job and when I finished the course immediately I got opportunity to give interview for even better job in Chevrolet Stars Motors and earning 7000 Rs per month. From the bottom of my heart I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude towards Aryaloka Computer Education for creating an opportunity for me and for others 100s of women's to change their worst lives into better life.
