PROGRESS TOWARDS OVERALL AIM OF THE PROJECT

The project has created a Society/Sangha environment during the period April-12 to March-13 for 703 students including boys=271, girls=432 and staff= 12, base on Liberty, Equality, and Fraternity taught by Dr. B. R. Ambedkar in which everybody has got opportunity to fulfil their needs, regardless of their background or beliefs. We created an atmosphere where youth (age between 12-20=446, 20-28=191, 28-35=60, 35 above=6) from different caste backgrounds (SC=400 + ST=62 + NT=27 + Hindu=22 + OBC=150 + Muslim=30 + Christian=9 + open=3) mix without discrimination in a friendly supportive non-violent learning environment.

Every year we aim to contribute to the realization of that vision by imparting computer education and personality development to the most disadvantaged parts of society 340 BPL students Including Boys=112 and girls=228. The project has a 13 yrs. long and successful track record in Nagpur of delivering education and has a strong approach to sustainability. During the period project has attracted 363 students including boys=159 and girls=204 those were able to pay a fee for education and trained these students alongside those needing support.

Students working together in this way breaks down many caste barriers in a supported environment.

Friendship, courage, independence, decision-making, determination, confidence, vision and professionalism are some of the many benefits students gained through the current Aryaloka project.

MAJOR ACHEIEVEMENTS

- We have successfully gone through the evaluation process conducted by Abhilash, Karuna trust and CBT team (Bhimrao Tupe, Tarahridaya). And plenty of lessens learn from Evaluation written in lesson learned sction.
- It's a very satisfied experience to see how the young students are mix together without caste discrimination.
- We have successfully delivered computer education to 340 students from disadvantage background.
- As per the record 25 students got jobs in computer related fields like Data entry operator, accounting, reception, publication, back office work, Computer designing, etc.

- We were able to attract 363 fee paying students that increase our confidence to move towards sustainability.
- We have open up the doors in IT field for 703 students.
- Over 8000 Young people from the disadvantaged have received exposure and training in Computer education during last 12 year. In last 3 years above 2028.
- Students become financially independed. During last 12 years 80 % students received jobs which are more than 6400. Of them 30% get job immediately after the course, and remaining during next 3 years.
- 40% students who receive job are in position to support their families. Most can earn enough to support their educational expenses
- Educating four hearing impaired students in computer knowledge in MSCIT, of them three passed.
- Students receive equality based treatment and environment regardless of their background (SC/ST/VJNT/Hindus/Muslim/ Tribal)
- 90% Parents trust Aryaloka institute regarding Girls safety, security and quality training and women's guidance
- Students develop communication skills, understanding, respectfulness, discipline and mature which help them to become effective in workplace
- Internship programes is a successful strategy which provided opportunity to over 25 BPL students to get work experience in 5 institutes. They gain experience in teaching IT skills, earning and personality development increasing employment prospect.
- 2 Coordinators working in Aryloka become well trained experience to look after centers independently. Seven people became intern in Aryloka Institute and are handling coordinators responsibilities else where.
- Every year over 30 % Students develop English speaking, and communication skills and acquire better jobs in English speaking environment earning Rs 5000/- to 7000/-.

CHALLENGES

- It is challenging to bring/collect students from most disadvantage background.
- It's even challenging to keep their interest for learning computer skills.
- Most of students found they are not regular on course its challenging keep them regular.
- It's challenging to teach the computer courses easily to BPL students than fee paying students.
- It's challenging to do further follow up with the students those were completed course.
- The ACE does not have self-owned building, ACE can be asked to vacate it with short notice. (it is rented building)
- Many Competitor computer institute arising around the Sadar Computer Institute
- ACE at Sadar branch can be asked to vacate at any time
- Negative publicity created by competitor institute in the same neighborhood will result in reduced paid and BPL student and publicity going down
- ACE not insured assets and premises.
- Staff leaves through dissatisfaction of salaries.
- Other new leaders cannot get developed because of the family relatives.

- We bought health insurance for all staff.
- We have decided to insured the office furniture and computers for theft and burn.
- Next year we trained surveyor to make a contact with the beneficiaries those have completed the course successfully in terms of getting more output whether they got jobs or not.
- Record should be proper
- Learning in regards with consequences of creating Objectives, budget, plan, maintain computerized data ,learn project background
- The staff must do work day to day not keep it as pending the work.
- ACE must follow the students who are not regular.
- Filling feedback forms from BPL plus Private students helps to improve our programe and project.
- Each co-coordinator realize their potential how to contribute to the success and aims of the ACE.
- ACE has established a good reputation and recognition with MKCL as organization with increasingly highest number of students, BPL support, English programme etc.
